

Now Available! The Blue Thumb Guide to Raingardens

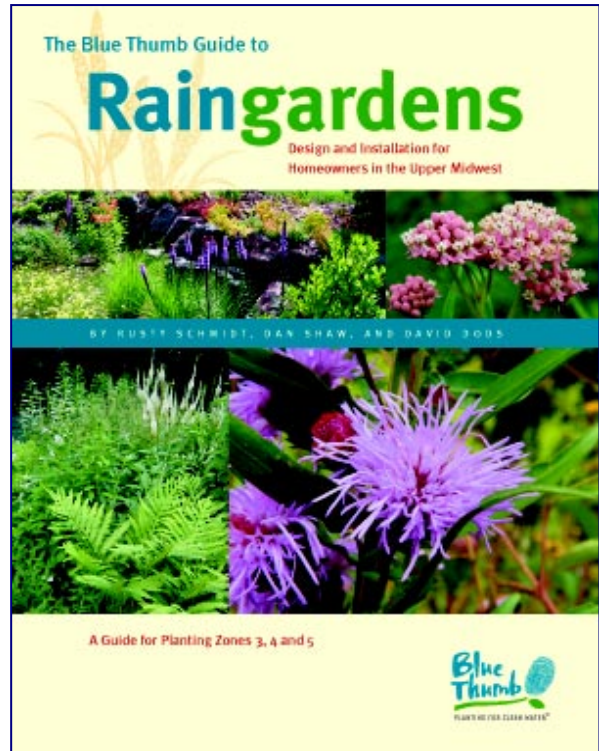
